# LIGHTS OF CHARTRES A UNIQUE EVENT IN THE WORLD

- The 13th edition of the Lights of Chartres (Chartres en Lumières) takes place from 16 April to 8 October 2016.
- 24 sites, all part of an exceptional historical heritage, are illuminated each night: Notre Dame Cathedral, listed as a UNESCO world heritage site (3 displays: royal gate/north gate/south gate), the old Episcopal Palace (grand façade of the Fine Arts Museum and the Bishop's Garden), churches, bridges, wash houses at the edge of the River Eure, the multimedia library, streets and squares of the upper town.

Among these 24 illuminations, 3 new displays will be introduced from day one:

- Fine Arts Museum, "Bishop's Garden" façade,
- The Theatre
- St André Collegiate Church;

and two displays will be revealed on 21 June:

- Fine Arts Museum, grand façade,
- Foulerie wash house.
- A second interactive light display animates Place Billard
- 176 consecutive nights of illuminations.
- A completely free event.
- An international light painting contest.
- A Celebration of Light on 17 September.

## WHAT'S NEW

Several new features are introduced on the occasion of the 2016 edition.

#### 3 new displays from 16 April




- Saint André Collegiate Church, a historic monument, is decorated with a different colourful scene, composed of four successive designs, every year as in the past 4 years.



- The theatre is mapped by the productions of the 4 winners of the 2015 video mapping contest:
- \* 1st prize: Alessio Cassaro presents *Opticks*: "A tribute to the studies on light by Isaac Newton." 2' 30"
- \* 2nd prize: Jean-Noël Beyssier/Flshka Design presents *Evolve*: "From the birth of the Earth to the world we know today, a few billion years of evolution." 2' 24"
- \* 3rd prize: *E(fée)mère* by Max Vallon/streed Lab: "The magical and rhythmic parade of an ephemeral and nocturnal creature." 2' 30"
- \* Crowd pleaser: *Theatre-Le miroir de la vie* by Laroslav Kostenko/Eurovideomapping: "art theatre, a form of knowledge about the world."
- Finally, the façade of the Fine Arts Museum, near the Bishop's Gardens, has a new display created by Camille Gross and Olivier Magermans: "Luna is a tale about the adventures of a small moon named Luna who goes out in search of her friend Stella. During her journey she takes us to different celestial worlds." 6' video










### From 9pm to 1am. 14th edition



This is a major event for the people of Chartres and all those who love to celebrate in a friendly family atmosphere.

On this occasion, the city will reveal the creations of the winners of the second edition of the light painting contest, chosen by a panel of professionals, as well as the winner of the "Crowd Pleaser" award.

This photography contest takes place from 29 March to 5 June. Light painting is a photographic technique that uses light to draw shapes during the shooting. The traces of light obtained by a long exposure time are an inevitable reference to the magic of Lights of Chartres.

## BEHIND THE SCENES

Behind the great showcase of Lights of Chartres, 3 technicians make sure that everything runs smoothly thanks to top of the line equipment:

- 5 giant image projectors (PIGI)
- 20 high-power video projectors
- 20 LED projectors
- 11 conventional projectors
- 12 halogen conventional projectors
- 12 loudspeakers
- 14 projection towers
- 22 synchronized and timed control systems.
- 1 million lumens (unit of light flow) used
- 148.8 kWh consumed
- 500 linear meters of analogue film

## HISTORY OF LIGHTS OF CHARTRES

The Lights of Chartres event has been animating the city for the past 13 years. The first Celebration of Light took place in 2002 and quickly became one of the city's most remarkable events, attracting tourists from around the world. Approximately one million visitors are expected each year.

Laurent Lhuillery, municipal councillor, entrusted with the enhancement of the city's heritage through light, explains: "Chartres is known as the City of Lights (and Perfume) thanks to the world-famous windows of its cathedral and the beautiful evening skies of the region of Beauce in autumn. In 2002, we wanted to extend this reputation and help visitors discover all of Chartres' heritage, including a great number of architectural treasures. For this, we wanted to use modern technology and show that we can combine ancient heritage and innovation. Many local people and businesses immediately joined the project. Chartres was the first city to highlight its heritage with light. It is now part of LUCI, the international network of cities on urban lighting."

This event is made possible by the involvement of municipal services and the support of local business partners as well as the local residents of Chartres.
